

# **Modular Event Counter**

#### **Product Parts**

- 1 Folding Counter Top
- 2 Adjusting Leg Bottom (x2)
- 3 Feet (x4)
- 4 Middle Leg
- 5 Small Locking Lever
- 6 Quick Release Pin
- 7 Connector Bracket\*
  The Connector Bracket
  is stored loosely in the
  Folding Table Top.
- 8 Large Locking Lever'
- 9 Graphic





# **Display Set-Up**

#### Step 1

Carefully unfold the Folding
Counter Top (1). The Connector
Bracket (7) is stored loosely, so
remove that and set it aside.
Line up the Middle Leg (4)
with the hole on the folding
counter's middle bars and
insert the Small Locking
Lever (5) through the hole.
Rotate the small pin until it
fits into the slot against
underside of the Counter
Top, as shown here:



#### Step 4

Unzip the Graphic (9) to drape it over the Counter Top. Zip it again to fit it to the frame.

### Step 2

Remove the Feet (3). Unfold the upper leg sections from the counter top and straighten the diagonal connecting bars. Insert the foot extensions on the ends of both Adjustable Leg Bottoms (2).



### Step 3

Insert the Adjustable Leg Bottoms (2) into the upper legs on the counter. Serveral height options are available (indicated by holes on the retractable portion). Adjust the extension to the desired height. The red button will snap when secure. Please note that a graphic will only display properly when the legs are fully extended.








## Step 5 (optional)

Two or more counters can be combined at their  $45^{\circ}$  edges.

\*\*The graphics must be on both counters before combining.\*\*

Insert the Connector Bracket (7) horizontally, with the holes upward, through the slits on both graphics. Align the bracket holes with the holes on the 45° bars and insert the Large Locking Lever (8) until it's completely through the bracket. Rotate the lever to snap into the slot on the counter's underside.

## **Storage & Care**

Disassemble with care and ensure all parts are securely attached to the underside of the folding counter top. Fold the two sides together and store in a cool, dry place.
